<u>Preamble</u>

THE ASSAM CO-OPERATIVE JUTE MILLS LTD., was commissioned in the year 1970. The mill after working for about 14 years had to be closed during March'1984 for acute financial crisis and accumulated losses. The mill was reopened on 1st January'1986 under the terms of the Assam Accord. After continuous struggles & efforts, the mill has started improving its economy from the year 1992-93 and making continuous progressive profits. Now, the mill is completely free from loans and liabilities, economically stable and providing an employment of about 900 local people

A. <u>Mission</u>

To manufacture jute goods and it's products marketing for contribution towards the socio-economic development of the surrounding areas and the states and solution of unemployment including relief to the jute growers.

B. OBJECTIVES

The objects of the Society are to encourage self-help, thrift and cooperation and proper development of agriculture, agricultural and other Industries and business and for that purpose it shall be competent for the Mills:-

- 1. To acquire land on purchase, lease or otherwise for the purpose of erection of factories, building, roads and means of transport.
- 2. To train members in improved methods of cultivation of jute and other crops and to supply seeds, manure, implements etc. for growing jute and other crops and to impart agricultural and industrial education if and when deemed necessary.
- 3. To manufacture various products out of jute procured from the members and others, to sell such manufactured goods and by-products to the best advantage of the Mills in markets in India and export goods to foreign markets.
- 4. To establish jute-manufacturing factories and to manage them by acquiring necessary plant & machinery and arranging required infrastructures.

D. OBLIGATION AND ASSISTANCE FROM GOVERNMENT

- 1. The Govt. will consider for provide a **DEDICATED** power line to the mill.
- 2. The Govt. will consider instructing the appropriate authority to accelerate the **AUDIT WORKS** and to complete within 3 months from the completion of the financial year.
- 3. The Govt. will consider to take up the matter with the Railway Authority for **ALLOTMENT OF PIECEMEAL WAGON** to the mill despite restriction
- 4. The Govt. will consider taking-up with the appropriate authority for providing reasonable amount of **TRANSPORT SUBSIDY** on jute products for marketing outside the N.E. Region due to geographically isolation.
- 5. The Govt. will consider instructing the various Govt. Department/P.S.U. to **PURCHASE** their requirement of Jute Packing Materials from the mill.

E. FREQUENCY OF MONITORING & INFORMATION FLOW

- 1. Half yearly within two month after completion of the half year.
- 2. Annual submission of self-evaluation report on MoU performance by 30-06-2007.
